
1. Problem

What is the distance between the two points p=(3,4) and q=(5,2) in a Cartesian coordinate system?

- (a) 4.058
- (b) 2.000
- (c) 0.827
- (d) 2.828
- (e) 4.848

Solution

The distance d of p and q is given by $d^2 = (p_1 - q_1)^2 + (p_2 - q_2)^2$ (Pythagorean formula). Hence $d = \sqrt{(p_1 - q_1)^2 + (p_2 - q_2)^2} = \sqrt{(3-5)^2 + (4-2)^2} = 2.828$.
